

To Owners, Managers and Masters of Malaysian Vessel,

- 1. Marine Department Malaysia (MARDEP) through Malaysia Shipping Notice <u>MSN 05/2018</u>, will be enforcing the requirement of the Data Collection System for fuel consumption on ships as required by the Protocol of 1978 amendment to International Convention for the Prevention Pollution from Ships (MARPOL) 1973, Annex VI, which highlights on the new Regulation 22A, for the requirement of collection and reporting of ship's fuel oil consumption data.
- 2. On or before 31st December 2018, the Ship Energy Efficiency Management Plan (SEEMP) for ships of 5,000 gross tonnage and above shall include a description of the methodology that is used to collect fuel oil consumption data. See also our previous <u>SCM Circular 02/2018</u>, issued on 30 January 2018 which guides on data collection and reporting.
- 3. The first mandatory cycle for fuel oil data collection and reporting will be in the calendar year 2019, from January 01st onwards. MARDEP will issue a Statement of Compliance (SOC) to ships that have satisfactorily submitted a complete data. The issuance of the SOC is based on the calendar year of the fuel oil data submitted.
- 4. Under the data collection system (DSC) for fuel oil consumption of Malaysia-registered ship, the Recognized Organization (ROs) including Ships Classification Malaysia (SCM) are authorized to:
  - i. review Part II of the SEEMP, the Methodology of Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Data Collection Plan;
  - ii. issue of the Confirmation of Compliance (COC) to ships using an approved sample format pursuant to regulation 5.4.5 of MARPOL Annex VI;
  - iii. verify the data for compliance with the regulation 22A of this Annex; and
  - iv. submit the verified data to the IMO Global Integrated Shipping Information System (GISIS) on behalf of Marine Department of Malaysia.
- 5. Owners and ship managers are advised to prepare and ensure compliance with this regulation.
- 6. Instruction letter from Marine Department of Malaysia can be found as *Annex 1*.

## THE FUEL OIL CONSUMPTION DATA COLLECTION SYSTEM (DCS) FOR MALAYSIA - REGISTERED SHIPS

## - RELATED DOCUMENT : MALAYSIA SHIPPING NOTICE MSN 05/2018.

As mentioned in the above related MSN, please take note of the data collection system for fuel oil consumption of ships as modified by the Protocol of 1978 relating to amendment to International Convention for Prevention Pollution from Ships (MARPOL) 1973, Annex VI.

2. On or before **31 December 2018**, the Ship Energy Efficiency Managament Plan (SEEMP) for ships of 5,000 gross tonnage and above shall include a description of the methodology that will be used to collect fuel oil consumption data. The first mandatory cycle for fuel oil data collection and reporting will be in the calender year 2019.

3. Marine Department Malaysia will only issue the Statement of Compliance (SOC) based on the data which have been satisfactorily verified by the Recognized Organization (ROs). The SOC will be issued to ships that have satisfactorily submitted a complete data and the issuance of the SOC is based on the calender year of the fuel oil data submitted.

4. Under the data collection system (DCS) for fuel oil consumption of Malaysia-registered ship, the Recognized Organization (ROs) are authorized to:

- i. review Part II of the SEEMP, the Methodology of Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Data Collection Plan;
- ii. issue the Confirmation of Compliance (COC) to ships using a approved sample format pursuant to regulation 5.4.5 of MARPOL Annex VI;
- iii. verify the data for compliance with the regulation 22A of this Annex; and
- iv. submit the verified data to the IMO Global Intergrated Shipping Information System (GISIS) on behalf of Marine Department Malaysia;
